DETAILS OF APPEAL

This appeal is brought under s 127(1) and (2) of the *District Court Act 1973* (NSW) and s 48(2)(f) of the *Supreme Court Act 1970* (NSW).

- 2 Leave to appeal was granted on
- The appellant appeal from the order of Gibson DCJ that the plaintiff's jury requisition be revoked and that the trial proceed before Gibson DCJ sitting without a jury.

APPEAL GROUNDS

- The primary judge erred by making an order under s 21(1A) of the *Defamation Act* 2005 (NSW) (**the Act**), where no such order was sought.
- The primary judge erred by holding that the appellant's ill heath could amount to an "other issue" within the meaning of s 21(1A) of the Act, and by making an order dispensing with a jury on that basis.
- The primary judge erred in making an order under s 21 of the Act dispensing with a jury on the basis of the appellant's ill health, where the respondents had not relied on such a basis, and had eschewed such reliance.
- The primary judge erred in not dismissing the respondents' application to dispense with the jury.

ORDERS SOUGHT

- 1 Appeal allowed.
- 2 Respondents to pay the appellant's costs of the appeal.
- 3 Set aside order 1 of the orders made by Gibson DCJ on 19 September 2025 and in place of such order, order that:
 - a. the defendants' motion to dispense with the jury under s 21 of the Defamation Act 2005 be dismissed:
 - b. there be a new trial, before a judge and jury.
- In the alternative to 3(b) order that there be a new trial before a judge alone.

UCPR 51.22 CERTIFICATE
