Women with disability experience domestic and family violence at much higher rates.

Building Access for Women with Disability is a four year project that will provide domestic and family violence services with information, support and resources to increase the accessibility of services for women with disability.

By supporting the increased accessibility of services, *Building Access for Women with Disability* will improve outcomes by:

- increasing safety, and
- reducing the likelihood of returning to violent situations or being at risk of homelessness.

The resources will be developed in partnership between the disability and domestic and family violence sectors.
