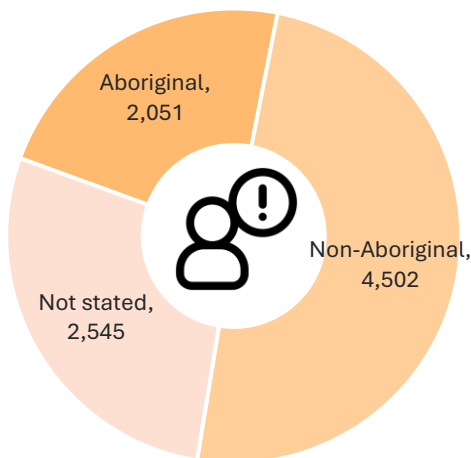

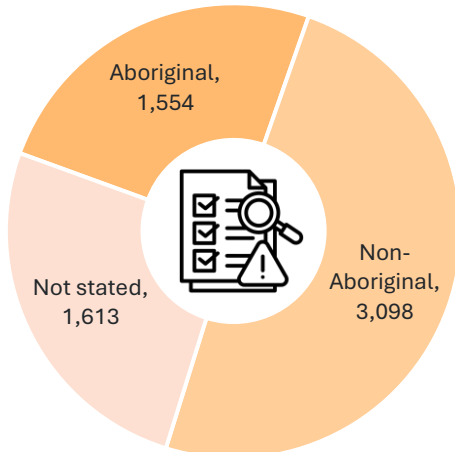

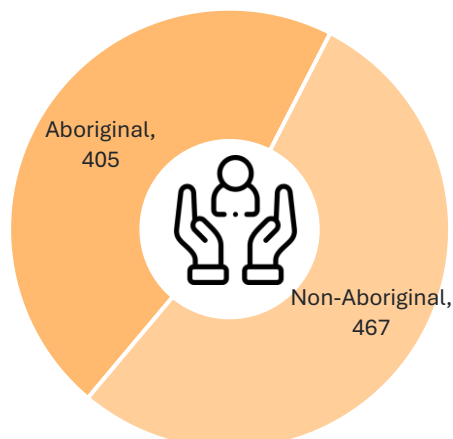
### Children & young people With a concern report<sub>2</sub>



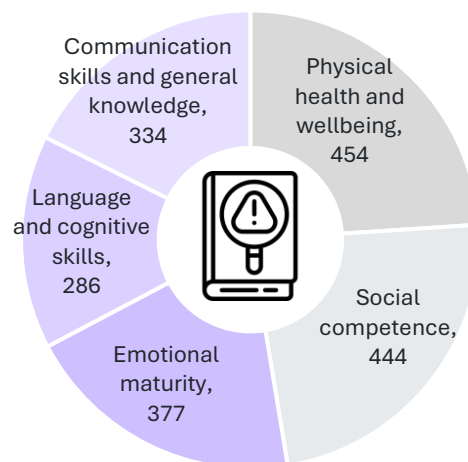
### With a ROSH report<sub>2</sub>



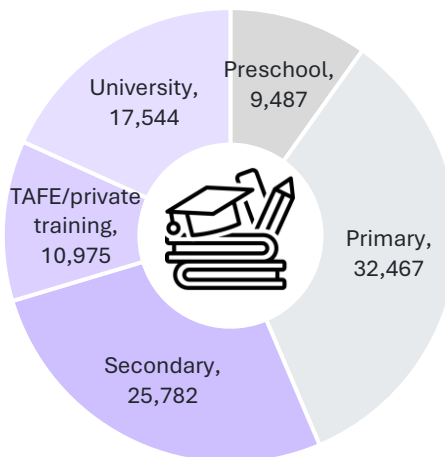
### In out-of-home care<sub>2</sub>



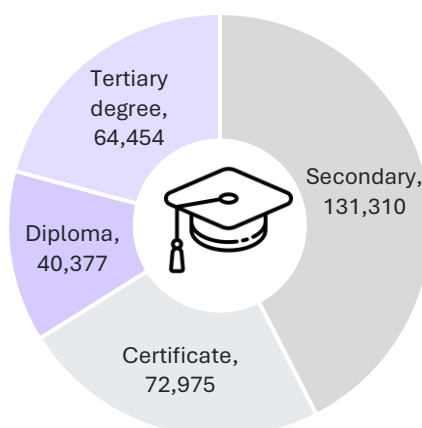
### Types of vulnerability for children in first year of school<sub>3</sub>



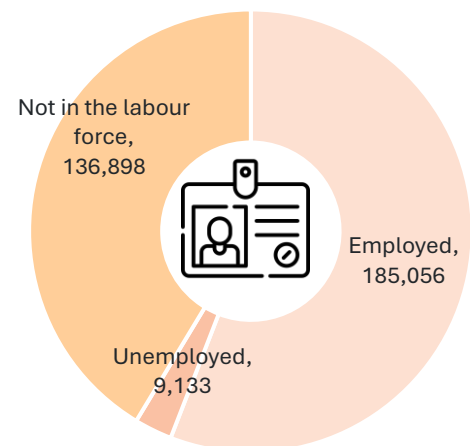
### Education attendance<sub>1</sub>



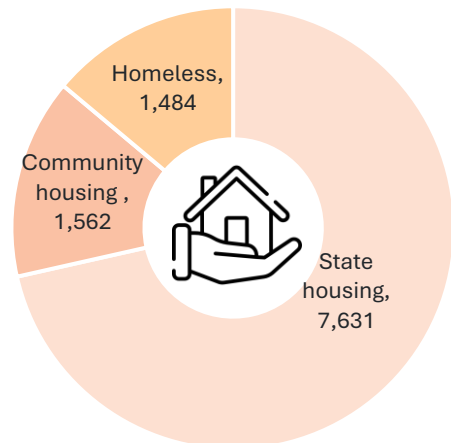
### Highest education achieved<sub>1</sub>



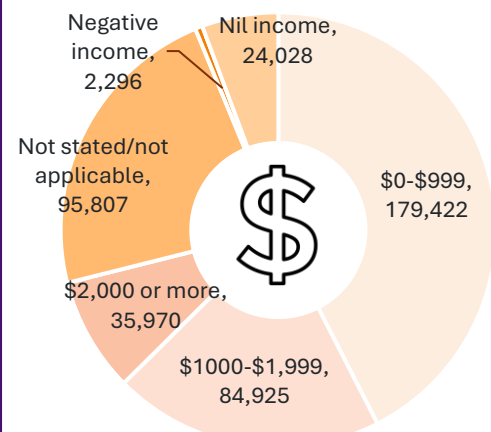
